Simply **bring your truck to the Gravenhurst TIS** on the following days, and weigh-in.

The lights at the scale will NOT be on - the truck must go into the scale with the lights off. They will then get weighed and recorded and be on their way. This should not take more than a few minutes.

The pilot is a partnership between The Ontario Aggregate Truckers Association (OATA), the Ontario Stone, Sand & Gravel Association (OSSGA), the Ontario Road Builders Association (ORBA) and the Ministry of Transportation (MTO). Once the pilot is complete, the information will be used to make a recommendation on how gross weights and axle weights are collected, stored and used for compliance.

*One weigh-in conducted before Dec. 31, 2018 will be randomly selected from the data. The registered owner of that vehicle will win the \$1,000 pre-paid VISA card, courtesy of OSSGA. The draw will take place January 7, 2019.
